## INFORMATION CLAUSE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

- 5) The legal basis for the processing of your personal data, listed in point 2 above, is the necessity to process them in order to complete the Agreement, in accordance with art. 6 sec. 1 point "b" of the GDPR.
- 6) The Administrator may also process your personal data on the basis of the Administrator's legitimate interest, which consists in pursuing any claims arising as a result of making the Agreement and providing contact for direct marketing of the Administrator's services in accordance with art. 6 sec. 1 point "f" of the GDPR.
